The Borough of Fanwood is proud to honor and recognize their service, and the sacrifices their families make to help protect our country. Since World War I, families have displayed a Blue Star to denote they have an active military servicemember. We display these Blue Star banners to remember the Fanwoodians currently helping protect our freedom, in alphabetical order:

**PFC David Belford**, 20, of Arlene Court, is currently serving with the 2/25 Marines in Iraq. He is a lifelong resident of Fanwood, having attended Brunner, Park Middle School and SPF High School.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Lt. Walter J. Biner**, 23, of Herbert Avenue, is currently stationed at Ft. Lewis in Washington, and is a member of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Armored Battalion and will soon be attending tank training at Ft. Knox, KY. He is currently deployed in Iraq. He is a 2003 graduate of SPFHS.

**Lt. Col. Timothy Callahan**, 43, formerly of Portland Avenue, is currently serving in the U.S. Marines in Oahu, HI. He participated in Operation Desert Storm in 1991, and in Operation Iraqi Freedom in both 2004 & 2006. He grew up in Fanwood where he attended School One, Park Middle and SPFHS.
